HAROLD E. REBHOLZ (PHS 1926)

Winning 11 letters at Portage High School in basketball, track, baseball and football, Mr. Rebholz continued his athletic career at the University of Wisconsin where he excelled as a defensive linebacker and offensive fullback. His experiences led him to a highly successful coaching career, beginning in Portage where he led the football team to consecutive undefeated seasons and introduced a range of sports, including boxing, tennis and golf between 1933 and 1934. His long, distinguished career culminated in Kearney, NJ where he retired in 1967. Mr. Rebholz's ability to draw out the best in his players and students was legendary. His honors include the Janesville Hall of Fame and the Wisconsin High School Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame.
