CHERYL VOIGHT (INDUCTED BY SHARI RATACZAK)

Cheryl Voight dominated in basketball, volleyball and track at Portage High School. She competed in volleyball from her sophomore year on at PHS and was named MVP in 1976. She also played basketball in these years and was awarded the top rebounder and scorer in this time period. Cheryl also excelled in track in the discus and shot put during her high school years and went to State from her sophomore year on. She placed in the top five in shot put her sophomore year and placed second her senior year along with a second place finish in discus. Cheryl had a discus throw of 145 feet in 1977 which was ranked seventh in the nation at that time.

At UW-Whitewater, Cheryl competed in volleyball and track and field. She was a member of the volleyball team from 1977 to 1980 and was named All-Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference in 1979 and helped lead the team to the 1980 WIAC championship. In addition to her volleyball accomplishments at UW-Whitewater, Cheryl also was a member of the track team from 1978 to 1981. She was the WIAC champion in the javelin throw in 1979 and 1980. She holds the school record in javelin 136 feet and 7 inches set in 1980, a record that will never be broken. Cheryl has also been name to the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater's Athletics Hall of Fame.
