Vickie was an MVP in track during her high school and college career, setting the pace as an all-American runner and helped secure PHS championships in basketball and volleyball. She lettered in volleyball, basketball and track from her sophomore year on at PHS. As a member of the PHS girls basketball team, Vickie went to sectionals every year in her high school basketball career and was all-conference in 1978. As a member of the PHS track and field team she won or placed second at the conference meet in the 100 meter, 200 meter and 880 team relays in 1976 and 1977. In 1978, she placed first in the 100, 200, 400 and long jump and was named MVP. She was also named MVP in 1979 while winning the 100, 200, and 400 and took second in the long jump. She qualified for State in 1978 and 1979 in the 400 and took fifth and seventh place respectively.

Vickie was also a very accomplished athlete and all-American at UW-Whitewater. She was named UW-Whitewater's MVP for both indoor and outdoor track in 1980 and 1982 and earned the team's Sportswoman of the Year in 1981 And 1982. She has also been named to the UW-Whitewater Athletics Hall of Fame.
